Point of departure

Enforcement of national RIVM regulations with regard to Covid-19

Responsibility

In the Netherlands, RIVM is the organization that has all the information and provides information about the course and the approach. The KNWU and the Grand Prix Adrie van de Poel Foundation follow the guidelines of the RIVM and bear its responsibility for cycling. [The NOC*NSF sports protocol](#) forms the basis for this. Professional (top) sports competitions

- Professional (top) sports competitions may take place, also before 5 a.m. and after 5 p.m.
- Public is NOT allowed

General guidelines

- Keep 1,5 meters away
- Wash/disinfect hands regularly
- Cough and sneeze into the inside of the elbow
- Avoid crowds
- Stay home if you have a cold and/or fever
- Follow and respect all Covid-19 related and references
- Wear a mouth mask if < 1.5 meters on the competition area and/or around it and in accessible buildings and covered areas
- It is not mandatory to wear a mouth mask during sports practice
- Consistent hygiene is important, responsible behavior of everyone is required
- Wash or disinfect hands after each use of joint material
- On arrival everyone washes their hands or disinfects them with disinfecting hand gel / hand alcohol

Checking the EU Digital Corona Certificate (EU DCC) or document

- For each individual who has a function on the competition area and/or around it, including accessible buildings or covered areas, is subject to an EU Digital Corona Certificate check via the CornaCheck app or via a document. He or she will then receive a wristband as an admission ticket to the competition area and/or around it. The wristband is available at the permanence after checking a valid EU DCC check
- Those who hold a position as manager or who lead a team, squad/equipe or delegate as responsible for those who directly or indirectly hold positions or participate on the competition area or around it are requested to sign a statement. The statement will be signed for receipt of admission tickets or wristbands and/or accreditations and/or back numbers **with the policy** that everyone under his or her leadership is in possession of a **valid EU DCC** and holds a position on the competition area and/or around it, including accessible buildings and covered areas or participate in one of the 2 competitions

The above regulations are made known by means of instructions (Appendix 1)

SARS-CoV-2 testing for access

With regard to testing for access, an additional exception is made for employees and/or volunteers who come into direct and indirect contact with participants/riders. This category is requested to undergo a SARS-CoV-2 rapid test prior to the competition. The rapid tests will be provided and performed by Sportdokters.nl who are responsible for medical assistance during the race day. This concerns the category of employees/volunteers:

1. Anti-doping control
2. Start/finish and/or around the ceremonial stage

Complaints during match day related to Covid-19

If anyone who has a position on the competition area and/or around it, including accessible buildings and covered areas, shows complaints that may be related to Covid-19, they are requested to go to the compound of Sportdokters.nl for a SARS-CoV-2 quick test.

If this test proves positive, Sportdokters.nl will follow the guidelines of the RIVM. This employee/volunteer will also be requested to end his or her work and to remove himself from the competition area in order to go into quarantine.

Physical measures

The following hygiene measures apply to every accessible building and covered area:

1. Wear a face mask except in a seat. If a seat cannot be guaranteed 1.5 meters, wear a mouth mask as well
2. If the 1.5 cannot be guaranteed on the competition area and/or around it, wear a mouth mask
3. Use disinfected hand gel. Hygiene materials are presented at each entrance to an accessible building and/or covered area.
4. Follow the walking routes and/or references


The above measures are made known by means of instructions (appendix 1)

- Permanence
 - Huijbergseweg 3, 4631 GC
- Anti-doping control
 - Huijbergseweg 10, 4631 GE
- All covered areas around the competition area
 - Scheldeweg and/or around it
